

## Curriculum Vitae ROBERTO BARBIERI

### Chief Executive Officer GESAC SpA

Born in Naples on February 4, 1953. Classical high school diploma, graduated with highest honors (summa cum laude) in Economic Sciences in 1978 from the University of Naples Federico II. He attended specialization courses in finance and corporate strategy at Italian and foreign universities.

In 1978 he began working at Finmeccanica, becoming one of the youngest company executives. He participated on behalf of Aeritalia-Finmeccanica in industrial agreements with Boeing and McDonnell Douglas, spending extended periods in the United States.

Subsequently, he moved to Iniziativa Meta (Montedison Group) where he became financial manager and simultaneously General Director of Il Messaggero S.p.A.

After completing his experience at Montedison, following a period at Aeritalia S.p.A. as financial executive, he joined the Ferrovie dello Stato group where he assumed the position of Financial Director of Metropolis S.p.A.

In December 1993 he began his political career as Councilor of the Naples Municipal Council for Strategic Resources (budget, taxes, shareholdings, assets, procurement, treasury). During this experience, two of the main projects were the first privatization of an airport in Italy (sale of Capodichino Airport to BAA) and the first bond issue by an Italian municipality on the American financial market.

In 1996 and 2001 he was elected Deputy. In 2006 he was elected Senator. From December 2006 he served as President of the Bicameral Commission of Inquiry on the waste cycle, elected unanimously.

In March 2008 he decided not to run in the last general elections and therefore left political activity to resume professional activity.

From April 2008 to May 2010, he worked as a corporate consultant for Alerion S.p.A., Health Care S.p.A. and GTT S.p.A. - Gruppo Trasporti Torinesi S.p.A.

Since June 2010 he has been Chief Executive Officer of GTT S.p.A.

In July 2013 he was appointed Chief Executive Officer of SAGAT S.p.A., and, in October 2017, he was also appointed President of SOGEAAL S.p.A., the management company of Alghero Airport.

**Since January 2019 he has been Chief Executive Officer of GESAC SpA, the management company of Naples Airport, which in November 2019 also acquired Salerno Airport through merger.**

Since February 2021 he has been President of GEASAR, the management company of Olbia Airport, and President of F2i Ligantia SpA.

In May 2025 the University of Naples Federico II conferred upon him the title of **Distinguished Graduate** for the significant contribution he has made to the development of the country's transport and infrastructure system and for the example of competence, integrity and strategic vision he has been able to offer throughout his career.
