- American Airlines' first direct flight from Philadelphia (PHL) landed in Naples today.
- Starting tomorrow, Friday, June 7, the new route will operate with a daily frequency throughout the summer season, until October 2024.
- Flights will be operated by modern Boeing 787-8 aircraft.
